

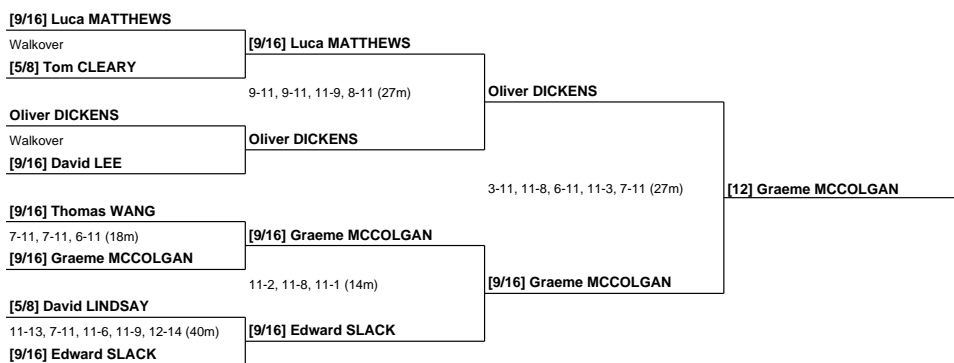
Main Draw

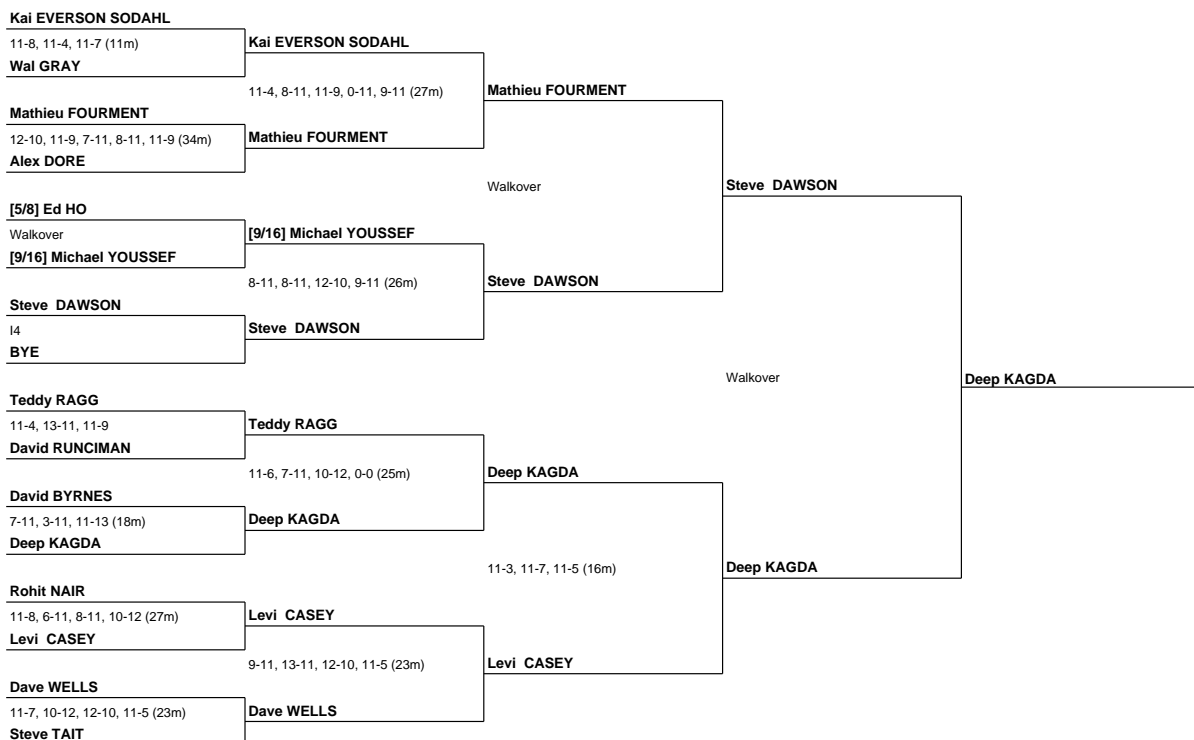
